

The EORTC is a Brussels-based international organization under Belgian law whose aims are to promote and coordinate cancer research in Europe. It is linked to other leading biomedical research organizations around the world. EORTC research takes place in over 200 hospitals, universities and cancer centers in 32 countries with the unique network of EORTC investigators comprising more than 2000 collaborating clinicians.

The EORTC Headquarters, located in Brussels, Belgium, provides both administrative and scientific support for the clinical trials carried out under its auspices.

SENIOR BIostatisticIAN (m/f)

The senior biostatistician's activities include the design, conduct, and analysis of phase I, II, and III cancer clinical trials, participation in EORTC research projects and teaching/training activities, and providing support to and the supervision of other staff members.

Scientific activities are coordinated through interaction with a multidisciplinary staff including other statisticians, medical doctors, data managers, and computer specialists.

The ideal candidate would have a Master's or PhD degree in biostatistics, a minimum of 5 to 10 years work experience in the statistical design and analysis of cancer clinical trials, a previous record of scientific research and publications, experience with the use of SAS and Microsoft Office, and excellent communication skills in English, both written and oral.
